Bachelor of Arts (General) (BA)

The Bachelor of Arts (General) degree provides you with the opportunity to discover what university really has to offer: the opportunity to develop skills in analysis, critical thinking, and good communication. The General Arts program is ideal if you are looking for a broad university education at the post-secondary level, or if you are exploring your options before electing a particular major or a specific discipline. Should your interests change as you move through the program, or should you decide you want to focus on a particular area of study, it is possible to move from the General Arts program into to a specific program major.

Admission Requirements

Graduates from any 2-year diploma program in General Arts and Science or Liberal Arts from an Ontario college, with a minimum average of 70%, may be considered for admission into the third year of the Bachelor of Arts (General Major) provided that they have completed at least two (2) one-semester courses of advanced academic content.

Applicants who have taken more than the minimum number of advanced level or second-year university courses as part of their college program may be eligible to receive up to two (2) university-level full credits of advanced standing.

Careers

The General Arts program at Lakehead University provides you with a diverse range of skill sets to prepare you for a variety of professional fields. Graduates may also choose to continue their education by pursuing graduate studies or other professional programs.
