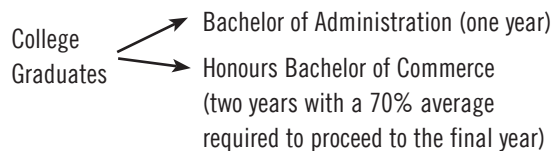


LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION/COMMERCE

Thunder Bay Campus

Lakehead University offers two comprehensive degree options for college business graduates. The Bachelor of Administration is designed for college transfer students who consider themselves generalists and wish to complete their degree in one year. The Honours Bachelor of Commerce degree is designed for those who wish to specialize, are prepared to invest in an additional year of education, and can meet the more demanding regimen of an honours program. The program can normally be completed in two years.



Teaching methodology in the Faculty of Business Administration includes case studies, computer simulations, reading seminars, group project work, role-playing and traditional test and lecture methods. Students are encouraged to join business-related campus clubs.

Bachelor of Administration

At a time when effective administration and management are playing an increasingly important role in our society, the need for skilled managers and administrators is greater than ever. These growing needs are reflected in the proliferation of courses and programs sponsored by a growing number of professional agencies, associations and institutes.

The Bachelor of Administration program has been carefully developed to provide an opportunity for those individuals interested in learning new analytical skills and techniques essential for their professional career development in a changing world. This program recognizes the growing demand of professional management associations and institutes requiring students to complete a university degree along with specified business management courses and programs.

Admission Requirements for the Bachelor of Administration

Graduates from a six-semester (three-year) Business Administration program, with a minimum B (GPA = 3.0 or 70%) cumulative average in Business courses, will be considered for the Bachelor of Administration program. Graduates of college Accounting, Human Resources Management, Marketing, General Business, and International Business programs must complete a specified college transfer program and are not required to complete make-up courses prior to the start of the program. (Note: Other diplomas will be considered on an individual basis.) The program can be completed in 8 months (September to April).

Honours Bachelor of Commerce

The Honours Bachelor of Commerce degree program has been designed to provide participants with exposure to all aspects of management in business and industry. The program prepares students to deal with the increasingly complex and dynamic environment in which business and industry must operate. Considerable emphasis is placed on techniques and conceptual analytical skills, which increase an individual's ability to cope with change and uncertainty. Consistent with this emphasis, focus is placed on the more creative aspects of decision making and problem solving in a business context.

The program has a strong core of required courses designed to familiarize students with the broad scope of management functions. You will be required to select a major from: **Accounting***, **Business Economics**, **Finance***, **General Management**, **Human Resources Management/Industrial Relations***, **International Business**, **Information Systems***, and **Marketing***.

* There is also a co-operative education option. To be considered for this competitive program a student must have satisfactorily completed all courses required for Year 3 of the Honours Bachelor of Commerce Program.

Admission Requirements for the Honours Bachelor of Commerce

Graduates from a six-semester (three-year) Business Administration program with a minimum B+ (GPA = 3.3 or 75%) cumulative average in Business courses will be considered for the Honours Bachelor of Commerce program. In addition to the minimum admissions average, applicants are also required to have specific courses from their background that are equivalent to years one and two of the program.

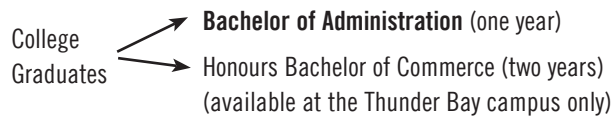
