








GENERAL TRANSFER

Lakehead individually assesses applicants for advanced standing from college programs for entry into most of our degree programs. If you are a graduate from a Community College and have an overall average of 3.0 (70%), you may receive up to 5 advanced standing credits for a 2-year diploma; 7.5 for a 3-year diploma; and 2 credits for a 1-year certificate.

INITIALIZE YOUR LAKEHEAD EMAIL ACCOUNT

After applying, Lakehead will send you an Acknowledgement Letter in which you are assigned a student ID number and username and password for a Lakehead email account. You should initialize this account and get into the habit of checking it regularly for updates.

LOGIN TO MYINFO

With the username and password assigned in your Acknowledgement Email, you should log in to the mylnfo portal on **lakeheadu.ca** to check what documents Lakehead has received or is awaiting, to see the status of your application, and to see what transfer credit you've been awarded.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Transfer credit refers to the number of course equivalents you may be awarded towards your Lakehead degree based on previous post-secondary studies at the college level. A minimum overall GPA of 3.0 (B or 70%) must be achieved in an accredited two- or three-year diploma program for transfer credit to be considered. One-year programs and partially completed diplomas are not eligible for transfer credit consideration. Results of the transfer credit assessment can be found on the "For Applicants" tab of myInfo under "My Transfer Credits." The amount of transfer credit received depends on a number of factors including grades, previous course work, and the program applied to at Lakehead University.

WHEN OFFERS ARE MADE

Lakehead University assesses most applications on a rolling basis as your documents are received. Applications to the Nursing programs are assessed in rounds which normally begin in March.


