In the field of political theory, you will examine the various benefits we seek through political organization, such as freedom, well-being, equality, and justice, and how best to achieve and safeguard them.

The **Sociology** degree program examines all aspects of life related to the fact that humans live in groups. These groups range from intimate relationships between individuals, through to impersonal forces that operate on national and global levels. Issues related to health and illness, crime and deviance, popular culture, social change, economy and society, schooling, social inequality, prejudice and discrimination are just some of the topics analyzed in Sociology courses.
