

LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT

EDUCATION

for graduates of an Early Childhood Education Diploma Program

As a Concurrent Education student, you will have the opportunity to take courses in both the Faculty of Education and the faculty offering your academic major, earning you two degrees at the same time. You will have the option to take a five-year or a six-year program, in which your final two years of study will take place exclusively within the Faculty of Education and which will qualify you for teacher certification by the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT). The final two years of your program will include courses and four 25-day teaching placements. First-year placements are completed in local boards and second-year placements may take place in one of the many school boards across Ontario that are affiliated with Lakehead University's Faculty of Education.

Primary-Junior (JK - Grade 6)

Offered at both the Thunder Bay and Orillia Campuses

Applicants to the Primary-Junior division do not need to choose teaching subjects; however, students should complete courses in at least three (3) core curriculum subjects taught in the Primary-Junior grades such as: English, French, Geography, History, Health and Physical Education, Mathematics, Music, Native Languages, Visual Arts, or science-based courses such as Anthropology (science courses only), Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Studies (science courses only), Geography (science courses only), Geology (Earth Sciences), Meteorology, and Physics.

Intermediate-Senior (Grades 7 - 12)

Offered at the Thunder Bay Campus

Students will specialize in two teaching subjects for the Intermediate-Senior division by completing five (5) full-year courses, or equivalent, in their first teaching subject and three (3) full-year courses, or equivalent, in their second teaching subject. See the subject table for a complete listing of teachable subjects offered in the Intermediate-Senior division. At least one relevant half-credit course at the upper-year level (third or fourth year) is required in both the first and second teaching subject.

Admission Requirements

Graduates of a two- or three-year diploma program in Early Childhood Education with a minimum overall average of 75% (GPA = 3.5, B+), may be eligible for transfer credit towards the first year of one of Lakehead University's Concurrent Education programs. *Please note that additional course prerequisites may be required based on desired teaching level and majors selected. Applicants are encouraged to contact Enrolment Services - Undergraduate Admissions to determine the exact requirements for entry into their program of choice.*

*Environmental Science	Courses used towards Environmental Science may be any combination from at least three of the following disciplines: Anthropology (Science stream only), Astronomy (see General Science courses), Biology, Chemistry, Geography (Science stream only), Environmental Studies (Science stream only), Geology, Meteorology (see General Science and Physics courses), Outdoor Recreation, and Physics.
French (2 nd Language)	Requires 5 FCEs in French for a first or second teachable.

Health & Physical Education	Requires a Kinesiology or Physical Education degree if applying as a first teachable.

Native Languages	Language stipulated - Requires 5 FCEs in Native Languages for a first or second teachable. Students may use a Native Language Teacher Certificate of Qualification from the Ontario College of Teachers to qualify for Native Language as a second teachable.

Science – General	Courses used toward General Science may be any combination from at least three of the following disciplines: Anthropology (Science stream only), Astronomy (see General Science courses), Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Studies (Science stream only), Geography (Science stream only), Geology, Meteorology (see General Science and Physics courses), and Physics.

Social Sciences – General (2 nd teaching subject only)	Can only be taken as a second teachable (requiring 3 FCEs). Courses counted toward this teachable may be any combination from at least three of the following disciplines: Anthropology, Philosophy, Psychology, Religious Studies, Sociology and Women's Studies.
Visual Arts	Visual Arts or Fine Arts degree required

NOTE: Lakehead University does not offer the following combinations of teaching subjects: Music Instrumental & Music Vocal; Mathematics with Environmental Science; Music with Visual Arts; and, Chemistry with Physics.
