RE: Report on Student Appeals, 2014-2015

Code of Student Behaviour and Disciplinary Procedures

Three appeals were considered by Tribunals of the Judicial Panel under the <u>Code of Student Behaviour and Disciplinary Procedures</u> (accessible on-line at https://www.lakeheadu.ca/faculty-and-staff/policies/student-related/code-of-student-behaviour-and-disciplinary-procedures) during the 2014-2015 academic year. Two involved academic misconduct, and one non-academic misconduct. In one academic misconduct case the appeal was affirmed and in the other the appeal was dismissed except for a reduction in one of the sanctions. In the non-academic misconduct case the appeal was dismissed.

Senate Academic Appeals Committee (SAAC)

During the 2014-2015 academic year two student appeals were heard by SAAC Tribunals under the Senate Policy Regarding Academic Appeals (accessible on-line at: https://www.lakeheadu.ca/faculty-and-staff/policies/student-related/reappraisal-and-academic-appeals). One was an appeal from an academic decision other than a final course mark, which was dismissed. The second involved an appeal concerning a final course mark; in this case the SAAC ordered a reassessment of an assignment in the course in question.
