The Senate Academic Committee (SAC) met on May 30, 2016.

1.0 Quality Assurance Subcommittee

1.1 SAC passed a motion to approve the SAC-QA's recommendation to approve the NEW - MSC Chemical Engineering Graduate Program (2015-ENG-4916) request and forward to the next appropriate committee.

2.0 SAC-OAG/C Subcommittee

SAC approved the report of SAC/-O-AGC that included the following:

2.1 Faculty of Business Administration

SAC-OAG/C will continue to work with the Faculty of Business Administration to develop the course descriptions to clearly meet the ICR criteria. SAC will reconsider these when received. A full report will be included in the September SAC Report to Senate.

2.2 School of Nursing

SAC passed a motion to accept the approach taken by the School of Nursing to integrate at least 18 hours of Indigenous contact across their curriculum with appropriate learner outcomes (Option 6, p. 2 in Senate-approved evaluation process of March 23, 2015).
