Subject: Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee Report

A. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #1-2016 OF 18 January 2016, ITEM 4.1

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on 11 March 2016 to review the following items referred from the 18 January 2016 Senate meeting:

1. Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies--Biology-NewConcentration-Plant Sciences (2015-SCI-5254)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. <u>Minor editorial revisions</u> were made to the average requirements.

2. Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies--COURSE-NEW-Biology4132 (2015-SCI-5356)

The Committee recommends approval of this request to create BIOL 4132.

3. Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies--Course-New-Environmental Studies 4470 - Global Change Biology (2015-SCI-5361)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request to create ENST 4470. Students who took this course as a special topic offering cannot take ENST 4470 for credit.

4. Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies--COURSE-MODIFY-Biology4230-CancerBiology (2016-SCI-5525)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. Minor editorial changes were made to the pre-requisite language for the course.

5. Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities--Program Changes (Sociology) related to ICR requirements (2015-SOC-5306-A)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. A standardized note regarding how the Indigenous Content requirement is being met was added to all programs within the request. The removal of the note that elective courses are chosen in consultation with an academic advisor was made in all programs. <u>Minor editorial revisions</u> were made to language regarding Type A and Type B course requirements and the organization of third year program requirements.

6. Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities -- Program Changes (Sociology) related to ICR requirements (2015-SOC-5306-B)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. It was confirmed that the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering had been consulted regarding the change to SOCI 2755 since it is a required course for students in Engineering programs.

7. Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities--Non-ICR Sociology course calendar changes (2015-SOC-5346)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. <u>Minor editorial revisions</u> were made to program requirements to be consistent with current Calendar language regarding FCEs and Types, and the standardized note regarding the Indigenous Content Requirement was added.

19. Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities--Courses-Modifications-UG-Visual Arts-Cross listing with Media Studies (2016-SOC-5531) The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of this request. The Media Studies crosslisted courses associated with this request were previously approved under request 2015-SOC-5429.
