DATE: 5 May 2015 (for May 14, 2015 Senate Meeting) – PART 1

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A. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #7-2014 OF OCTOBER 20, 2014, ITEM 5

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on April 15, 2015 to review the following item that was referred from the October 20, 2014 Senate meeting.

.1 Faculty of Education

(a) (2014-EDU-4328 now 2014-EDU-4409) – HBEEd Program Change to 5 Year

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to the HBEEd degree (now a 5-year program) with revisions made in consultation with the Chair of the Department of Aboriginal Education, including a list of the courses used in the calculation of the major average in Aboriginal Education.

B. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #8-2014 OF DECEMBER 1, 2014, ITEM 4.1

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on April 22, 2015 to review the following item that was referred from the December 1, 2014 Senate meeting.

.1 Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies

(a) (2014-SCI-4463-A) New Courses – Biology Aquatic Field Courses [BIOL 4152]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Biology 4152, with revisions (to title, offering hours and prerequisite) made in consultation with the Chair of the Department.

D. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #1-2015 OF JANUARY 19, 2015, ITEM 4.1

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on April 10, 15, 17, 22, 24, and 29, 2015 to review the items that were referred from the January 19, 2015 Senate meeting and makes the following recommendations.

.1 Faculty of Education

(a) 2015-EDU-4691 – Education Courses Deletions and Revisions

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed deletions and changes to Education courses, with minor editorial revisions to the descriptions of Education 3232, 3235 and 3270.

.2 Faculty of Engineering

(a) 2014-ENG-4547 – Remove ENGI 2332 & 3336 Change (Mechanical)

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed revisions in the BEng (Mechanical Engineering) degree: remove Engineering 2332 from Second Year Winter Term and add a one hour lab to Engineering 3014, and revise the title and offering of Engineering 3336 in Fourth Year Winter Term.

(b) 2015-ENG-4705 – Chemical Engineering – Additional Program Change

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions in the BEng (Chemical Engineering) degree.

(c) 2015-ENG-4706 – Chemical Engineering – Course Additions, Changes and Deletions

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed changes, additions and deletions in Chemical Engineering courses, with revisions. In Engineering 0334, 0631, 0673, 0676 and 0677, Engineering 3070 was added as both prerequisite and co-requisite. For Engineering 0335, the prerequisite Engineering 1554 and 2331 and 3070, and co-requisite Engineering 3070 was added. For Engineering 0653 and 0672, Engineering 3070 was also added to the new prerequisite. The end term for Engineering 0533, 0551, 0630, 1137, and 2450 is 2014-15. The course descriptions for Engineering 0676, 0677 and 3434 were revised as complete sentences. The first sentences of Engineering 1150 and 3338 were slightly revised.

(d) 2015-ENG-4733 – BENG Admission Requirement

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions to the Faculty of Engineering's requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering degree programs.

(e) 2015-ENG-4742 – ENGI Common Year Admission Requirement

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions to the Faculty of Engineering's requirements for admission to the Common Year in Applied Science.

.3 Faculty of Health and Behavioural Sciences

(a) 2014-HBS-4514 – Course-New Course-Psychology (PSYC 3350) [see 2014-SOC-4665]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Psychology 3350, cross-calendared with Criminology 3350 (request 2014-SOC-4665), with a small wording change in the course description.

.4 Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies

(a) 2014-SCI-3202 – BA 3 yrs (Anthropology Major Orillia

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposal to offer the BA (Anthropology Major) at the Orillia Campus, with one revision to the program description. In First Year, (b) the wording should be changed to Type A courses and in (d) the wording should be changed to Type B courses.

(b) 2014-SCI-3203 – BA (Anthropology Major) Orillia

The Committee recommends approval of the proposal to offer the BA (Anthropology Major) 4 Year Non-Direct Entry program at the Orillia Campus.

(c) 2014-SCI-3204 – BSc 3 yrs (Anthropology Major) Orillia

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposal to offer the BSc (Anthropology Major) at the Orillia Campus.

(d) 2014-SCI-3205 – BSc (Anthropology Major) Orillia

The Committee recommends approval of the proposal to offer the BSc (Anthropology Major) 4 Year Non-Direct Entry program at the Orillia Campus.

(e) 2014-SCI-3206 – HBA (Anthropology Major) Orillia

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposal to offer the HBA (Anthropology Major) at the Orillia Campus, with an editorial revision to add the requirements of the first three years to the program description.

(f) 2014-SCI-3207 – HBSc (Anthropology Major) Orillia

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposal to offer the HBSc (Anthropology Major) at the Orillia Campus, with an editorial revision to add the requirements of the first three years to the program description.

(g) 2014-SCI-3208 – Minor in Anthropology Orillia

The Committee recommends approval of the new Minor in Anthropology program to be offered at both the Thunder Bay and Orillia Campuses.

(h) 2014-SCI-4613 – 3rd/4th Year Geography Course Requirements [Program Changes]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to third and fourth year Geography program requirements with two revisions. In Fourth Year (b) of the HBES (Geography Major), the one FCE in Geography should be at the third or fourth year level (to match the new requirements in the other honours programs). In Third Year (c) of the HBSc (Geography with Geology Minor), the phrase "permission of the Department" was removed.

(i) 2015-SCI-4688 – Programs Modification UG Computer Science IQAP response

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed revisions to the three programs in Computer Science that includes the removal of the Hardware Option, with editorial revisions, and with the clarification that changes for students in all year levels will become effective this September 2015.

(j) 2015-SCI-4710 – New Course ENSU 4111

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 4111, with revisions. The first sentence of the course description should be revised slightly and the course should be designated as a required course, Type C.

(k) 2015-SCI-4711 – New Course ENSU 4033

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 4033, with revisions. The first sentence and second-last sentence of the course description should be revised slightly and the course should be designated as a required course, Type B or C.

(l) 2015-SCI-4712 – New Course ENSU 3111

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 3111, with a minor wording revision in the first sentence of the course description. In addition, the cross-calendar with Geography 3431 and Environmental Studies 3431 will be removed at this time.

(m) 2015-SCI-4713 – New course ENSU 2111

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 2111, with revisions. The title will be "Environmental Thought and Policy" and the first sentence of the course description will be revised slightly.

(n) 2015-SCI-4715 – BASC Environmental Sustainability – 4 Year non-direct entry

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed four-year non-direct entry program, BSc (Environmental Sustainability Major) 4 Year.

(o) 2015-SCI-4722 – Seminar in Environmental Sustainability

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 4010, to replace Interdisciplinary Studies 4010, in the Environmental Sustainability programs.

(p) 2015-SCI-4723 – New course ENSU 4901

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new course, Environmental Sustainability 4901, to replace Interdisciplinary Studies 4901, in the Environmental Sustainability programs.

(q) 2015-SCI-4731 – Program changes to HBASC Environmental Sustainability

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes in the HBASC (Environmental Sustainability Major), with revisions. In First Year, Natural Resources Management 1010 is moved from (c) to a recommended course in (h) where the electives are increased from one half-course to one FCE. In Second Year, the electives need to be reduced from one FCE to one half-course. In Third Year, the electives need to be increased from one and one-half FCEs to two FCEs.

(r) 2015-SCI-4732 – Changes to HBASC.ENVS.CP

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed changes in the HBASC (Environmental Sustainability Major), with similar revisions. In First Year, NRMT 1010 is moved from (c) to a recommended course in (h) where the electives are increased from one half-course to one FCE. In Second Year, the electives need to be reduced from one FCE to one half-course. In Third Year Winter Term, the electives need to be increased from one and one-half FCEs to two FCEs.

.5 Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities

(a1) 2014-SOC-4484 – Discontinued Course – MDST 2410

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Media Studies 2410.

(b1) 2014-SOC-4485 – MDST 2010 Course Change

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the revised title and removal of prerequisite for Media Studies 2410.

(c1) 2014-SOC-4486 – Course change – MDST 2210

The Committee recommends approval of the revised title and description for Media Studies 2210 with one revision. The prerequisite permission should be revised from instructor to Chair of the Department.

(d1) 2014-SOC-4487 – Course change – MDST 3410

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the revised title for Media Studies 3410 with one revision. The prerequisite should be removed and the proposed new wording added as a restrictive Note instead "May only be taken by students at 3rd or 4th year level".

(e1) 2014-SOC-4508 – DESCRIPTION CHANGE TO POLI 3314 and 3332

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed changes to two Political Science courses with minor editorial revisions.

(f1) 2014-SOC-4522 – History Changes – Aboriginal Content and Groupings [Program Changes]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to History programs with revisions. In the First Year, Group I will be replaced by Type A courses and Group II will be replaced by Type B courses. The first year requirements will be added to the HBA program description. In the HBA (History and Philosophy Majors), Fourth Year (b) should be Two FCEs in Philosophy at the third or fourth year level.

(g1) 2014-SOC-4523 – History Concurrent Changes – Aboriginal Content and Groupings [Education Program Changes]

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed changes to History concurrent Education programs with revisions. The First Year requirement should be two FCEs from Type B courses and the first year requirements will be added to the HBA/BEEd program descriptions.

(h1) 2014-SOC-4563-A – Women’s Studies Major Modification – Programs split into:

2014-SOC-4563-A-A Women’s Studies Major Modification – Programs

2014-SOC-4563-A-B Women’s Studies Major Modification – Programs

[HBORHBA (Wome)]

Request 2014-SOC-4563-A-B has not yet been forwarded to SUSC.

Request 2014-SOC-4563-A-A

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to Women’s Studies programs (with the exception of the HBORHBA in request 2014-SOC-4563-A-B), with revisions. The new classification Type A and Type B should replace Group I and Group II in First Year. Fourth Year (e) of the HBA (Women’s Studies Major) and HBABEd (Women’s Studies Major) J/I and P/J should be two, not one FCE electives.

(i1) 2014-SOC-4565 – Course Change OUTD 1010

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the revised course description for Outdoor Recreation 1010.

(j1) 2014-SOC-4567 – Course Change OUTD 1150

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the revised title for Outdoor Recreation 1150.

(k1) 2014-SOC-4568 – Course Change OUTD 2270

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the removal of the prerequisite and addition of labs to offering hours for Outdoor Recreation 2270.

(l1) 2014-SOC-4569 – Course Deletion (Renumbered) OUTD 2310

The Committee recommends approval of the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 2310.

(m1) 2014-SOC-4571 – Course Deletion OUTD 2750

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 2750.

(n1) 2014-SOC-4572 – New Course OUTD 2755

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the new course, Outdoor Recreation 2750, with revised offering hours, to begin in the 2016-17 academic year.

(o1) 2014-SOC-4573 – New Renumbered Course OUTD 2511

The Committee recommends approval of the new course, Outdoor Recreation 2511, with revised offering hours "3-0; or 3-0".

(p1) 2014-SOC-4574 – Course-Revise Prerequisite INDI 3501

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the removal of the prerequisite for Indigenous Learning 3501.

(q1) 2014-SOC-4576 – New Renumbered Course OUTD 1310

The Committee recommends that Senate to approve the new course, Outdoor Recreation 1310, renumbered from Outdoor Recreation 2310.

(r1) 2014-SOC-4577 – Course Deletion OUTD 2810

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 2810, at the end of the 2015-16 academic year.

(s1) 2014-SOC-4578 – Course Deletion OUTD 2910

The Committee recommends approval of the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 2910, at the end of the 2015-16 academic year.

(t1) 2014-SOC-4579 – Course Deletion OUTD 2930

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 2930, at the end of the 2015-16 academic year.

(u1) 2014-SOC-4583 – Course Deletion OUTD 3771

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 3771, at the end of the 2017-18 academic year, since the course is a required course in the Specialization in Tourism and should not be removed until after all students had completed their specializations.

(v1) 2014-SOC-4584 – Course Changes OUD 3050

The Committee recommends approval of the revised title and prerequisite, and addition of the lab to the offering hours of Outdoor Recreation 3050, with two revisions. The prerequisite only needs to show the renumbered course, OUTD 2511 and the offering hours should be "2-2; or 2-2".

(w1) 2014-SOC-4585 – Course Deletion (Renumbered) OUTD 3511

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Outdoor Recreation 3511, at the end of the 2016-17 academic year.

(x1) 2014-SOC-4588 – Women's Studies Major Modification – Courses (PART 1)

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the Women's Studies course changes, with revisions. The sentences with information regarding Indigenous/Aboriginal content will be removed from WOME 1100 and 2119. The prerequisite exemption statement will be "permission of the instructor and Chair of the Department"; for cross-calendared courses owned by Women's Studies, the statement will be "permission of the instructor and Chair of the Department of Women's Studies"; for cross-calendared courses owned by another department the permission will be from the Chair of that department. The Women's Studies Course Classification will be added to the course descriptions of the "parent" course for Women's Studies cross-calendared courses. Changes to existing Women's Studies courses or additions of new Women's Studies courses, cross-calendared with English, will become effective in the same academic year.

Because of the volume of changes required in the "parent" department courses cross-calendared with Women's Studies, the Calendar Officer will make the associated changes in Curriculum Navigator on their behalf.

(y1) 2014-SOC-4589 – Women’s Studies Major Modification – Courses (PART 2)

2014-SOC-4589-A - Women’s Studies Major Modification – Courses (PART 2)

2014-SOC-4589-B WOME 4916 New Version

Request 2014-SOC-4589 was split into 2014-SOC-4589-A and 2014-SOC-4589-B. Request 2014-SOC-4589-B, containing the new version of WOME 4916, was cancelled. In place of the new version of WOME 4916, a discontinued version of WOME 4916 and a new course WOME 4016 was added to request 2014-SOC-4589-A.

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the Women’s Studies course changes (Part 2), with revisions. The prerequisite exemption statement will be “permission of the instructor and Chair of the Department”; for cross-calendared courses owned by Women’s Studies, the statement will be “permission of the instructor and Chair of the Department of Women’s Studies”; for cross-calendared courses owned by another department the permission will be from the Chair of that department. The Women’s Studies Course Classification will be added to the course descriptions of the “parent” course for Women’s Studies cross-calendared courses. Changes to existing Women’s Studies courses or additions of new Women’s Studies courses, cross-calendared with English, will become effective in the same academic year. The first sentence of the course description of Women’s Studies 3355 will be revised slightly and the equivalency statement in the restrictive note deleted.

Again, because of the volume of changes required in the “parent” department courses cross-calendared with Women’s Studies, the Calendar Officer will make the associated changes in Curriculum Navigator on their behalf.

(z1) 2014-SOC-4590 – Program-Major Modification HBORBA.GEOG

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the major modifications in the HBOR, BA (Geography Major) program, with revisions. Second Year (c) should be “Two of: Geography 2331, 2351, 2511, 2811”, Third Year (c) should be “The two remaining courses in Second Year (c) above from: Geography 2331, 2351, 2511, 2811”, the one FCE elective in Fourth Year (d) should be deleted, and the Notes below Fourth Year should be deleted.

(a2) 2014-SOC-4591 – Program – Major Modification HBORBSC.NATU

The Committee recommends approval of the major modifications in the HBOR, BSc (Natural Science Major) program, with editorial revisions.

(b2) 2014-SOC-4592 – Program-Major Modification HBOR

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the major modifications in the HBOR program, with editorial revisions and the deletion of the Note below Fourth Year.

(c2) 2014-SOC-4593 – Major Modification HBORBA.HIST

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the major modifications in the HBOR, BA (History Major) program with revisions. The History courses in Fourth Year (c) should be at the third year level only, the electives in Fourth Year (d) should be reduced from 1.5 to one FCE, and the Notes below Fourth Year should be deleted.

(d2) 2014-SOC-4598 – Program-Major Modification-4 Yr Non-Direct Entry BOR for HBOR

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new four-year Non-Direct Entry Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation program.

(e2) 2014-SOC-4599 – Course Deletion – MDST 3030

The Committee recommends approval of the discontinuation of Media Studies 3030.

(f2) 2014-SOC-4600 – English Curriculum Major Modifications New 3rd year courses
The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new third-year courses in English to start in the 2016-2017 academic year, with revisions. The courses, English 3750 and 3751, will not be cross-calendared with Indigenous Learning at this time. The cross-calendared course, English 3810/Women's Studies 3810, will be titled "Special Topics in Women's Writing" and will be designated a special topics course type. The description of the fourth-year special topics courses, English 3050, 3051, 3052, and 3053 will be revised slightly.

(g2) 2014-SOC-4601 – Course Deletion – MDST 3050
The Committee recommends that Senate approve the discontinuation of Media Studies 3050.

(h2) 2014-SOC-4602 (now 2014-SOC-4602-A) – English Curriculum Major Modifications Revised 3rd year courses
The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new versions of third-year English courses to start in the 2016-2017 academic year, with revisions. The request was split and Part B containing the new version of English 3817 (removing the special topics designation) was deleted. A renumbered course, English 3017 (not a special topics course), was added to the new courses request 2014-SOC-4600 and the existing special topics course, English 3817, was added to request 2014-SOC-4603. The title of English 3031 will not be revised.

(i2) 2014-SOC-4603 – English Curriculum Major Modifications Discontinued 3rd year courses
The Committee recommends approval of the proposed discontinued third-year English courses to end after the 2015-2016 academic year, with the addition of English 3817, as noted in request 2014-SOC-4602-A above.

The Committee notes that the Department of Women's Studies has submitted an associated request, 2014-SOC-4589-A, to discontinue Women's Studies 3819, cross-calendared with English 3819; however, the Department of Indigenous Learning will need to submit a request to discontinue Indigenous Learning 3819.

(j2) 2014-SOC-4604 – English Curriculum Major Modifications New 4th year courses
The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new fourth-year English courses to start in the 2016-2017 academic year, with revisions. The new course, English 4016 (previously English 4916), as noted in request 2014-SOC-4605, below, was added. The course descriptions of these special topics courses were revised slightly. English 4012 will not be cross-calendared with Indigenous Learning 4012 at this time.

The Committee notes that the Department of Women's Studies submitted an associated cross-calendared course in request 2014-SOC-4589-A.

(k2) 2014-SOC-4605 (now 2014-SOC-4605-A) – English Curriculum Major Modifications Revised/Discontinued 4th year Courses
The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new versions of fourth-year courses to start in the 2016-2017 academic year and discontinued fourth-year English courses to end after the 2015-2016 academic year, with revisions. The request was split and Part B containing the proposed new version of English 4916 was deleted. A renumbered course, English 4016 (designated a special topics course in the series of new courses), was added to the new courses request 2014-SOC-4604 and the existing course, English 4916, was added to this request 2014-SOC-4605 to be discontinued instead. The course descriptions of English 4010 and 4914 were revised slightly.

(l2) 2014-SOC-4606 – Media Studies course revisions

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to four Media Studies courses with revisions. In Media Studies 3510, the prerequisite will be deleted and the proposed new wording will be added as a restrictive Note “May only be taken by students at 3rd or 4th year level.” Because request 2014-SOC-4642 also contained revisions to Media Studies 4350, the revisions were moved to request 2014-SOC-4606 and request 2014-SOC-4642 was cancelled. One revision will be made in the proposed cross-calendaring of the new course, Women’s Studies 4350, with the existing course, Media Studies 4350; the permission statement in the prerequisite should be changed from instructor to Chair of the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies.

(m2) 2014-SOC-4609 – Women’s Studies Courses Information Page – Simplified

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed restructuring of the Women’s Studies Courses Information page, to replace the lists of courses with the definitions of the Women’s Studies Course Categories. The course category designation(s) will be added to each Women’s Studies course.

(n2) 2014-SOC-4610 – English Curriculum Major Modifications Concurrent-Ed Majors [Program Changes]

The Committee recommends that Senate to approve the proposed revisions to concurrent Education programs with English Majors, including the HBA, BEd (English Major) P/J, now also being offered on the Orillia Campus.

The Committee notes that the same revisions will also be made to the associated 2 Year BEd concurrent programs in requests 2104-EDU-4386, 2014-EDU-4399, and 2014-EDU-4403.

The Committee further notes that the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies is making revisions to the Fourth Year Interdisciplinary Studies requirements that will necessitate further revisions to the HBASc and HBAScBEd programs in English.

(o2) 2014-SOC-4611 – Media Studies course revisions

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed changes in Media Studies, with revisions. In the course description of Media Studies 2310 removed “and the United States” in the first sentence. In Media Studies 4310, 4330, 4530 and 4550, instead of a prerequisite, add a restrictive Note “May only be taken by students at the 3rd or 4th year level”.

(p2) 2014-SOC-4612 – New courses in Criminology

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed two new Criminology courses, with revisions. In Criminology 4801, the course description should begin “Through a combination of seminars and independent study, students will...” and a restrictive statement should be added to the Notes “Students who have previous credit in Interdisciplinary Studies 4010 and 4032 may not take Criminology 4801 for credit.”

(q2) 2014-SOC-4617 – INTD 4XXX course addition

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new full-course credit, Interdisciplinary Studies 4801, with revisions. The course description will be revised to include information about the seminar component of the course, and the restrictive Note will be reworded in standard calendar wording.

(r2) 2014-SOC-4622 – Course Title change for MDST 2310

This request was deleted by initiator because the revisions were already included in request 2014-SOC-4611.

(s2) 2014-SOC-4625 – Change to HBASc Media Studies college transfer

The Committee recommends approval of the changes to the HBASc (Media Studies Major) College Pathways Program.

(t2) 2014-SOC-4630-B Sociology Course Changes [SOCl 3455 and 3555]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the two proposed new courses in Sociology, SOCl 3455 and 3555, that were split from the Sociology course revisions, section A.

Discussion of the information in the Additional Teaching Space section raised concerns about the possible inability to deliver the courses to students in Orillia. The concerns were brought to the attention of the Senate Budget Committee.

(u2) 2014-SOC-4634 – Changes to HBASC degree

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to the HBASc (Interdisciplinary Studies Major), with one correction. Note 3 should be removed because it only applies to concurrent Education programs.

(w2) 2014-SOC-4636 – Changes to HBASC.ED P/J

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed changes to the HBASc, BEd (Interdisciplinary Studies Major) P/J.

(x2) 2014-SOC-4637 – Creation of MDST 2113 to be cross-listed with WOME 2113

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new course, Media Studies 2113, cross-calendared with the existing course, Women's Studies 2113. The Committee recommended changing the permission statement in the prerequisite from the instructor to Chair of the Department of Women's Studies.

(y2) 2014-SOC-4638 – Creation of MDST 3133 to be cross-listed with WOME 3133

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Media Studies 3133, cross-calendared with the existing course, Women's Studies 3133. The Committee recommended changing the permission statement in the prerequisite from the instructor to Chair of the Department of Women's Studies.

(z2) 2014-SOC-4639 – Creation of MDST 3214 to be cross-listed with WOME 3214

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed new course, Media Studies 3214, cross-calendared with the existing course, Women's Studies 3214. The Committee recommended changing the permission statement in the prerequisite from the instructor to Chair of the Department of Women's Studies.

(a3) 2014-SOC-4640 – Cross-listing of MDST 2410 with POLI 2410

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed new course, Media Studies 2411, cross-calendared with the existing course, Political Science 2410, with one revision. The proposed prerequisite should be changed to a restrictive Note.

(b3) 2014-SOC-4642 – Cross-list MDST 4350 with WOME

Because request 2014-SOC-4642 also contained revisions to Media Studies 4350, the revisions were moved to request 2014-SOC-4606 (above) and request 2014-SOC-4642 was cancelled.

(c3) 2014-SOC-4651 – Rename Minor in Prof Ethics (PHIL)

The Committee recommends that Senate approve proposed renaming of the Minor in Professional Ethics to the Minor in Applied Ethics, with reformatting into two separate sections and one correction. The course, Philosophy 3514, should not be removed from the list of third year courses.

(d3) 2014-SOC-4652 – Changes to BASC degree

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed revisions to the BASc (Interdisciplinary Studies Major), with one correction. Note 3 should be removed because it only applies to concurrent Education programs.

(e3) 2014-SOC-4653 – Changes to BASC.TRF degree

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions to the BASc (Interdisciplinary Studies Major) College Pathways program.

(f3) 2014-SOC-4654 – Changes to BASCED.PJ degree

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions to the BASc, BEd (Interdisciplinary Studies) P/J program.

(g3) 2014-SOC-4655 – Changes to HBASC.CRIM.TRF degree

The Committee recommends approval of proposed revisions to the HBASC (Criminology Major) Transfer program. It was clarified that the Third Year change from INTD 4010/4032 to CRIM 4801 would become effective immediately.

(h3) 2014-SOC-4658 – Changes to HBASC.TRF

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed revisions to the HBASC (Interdisciplinary Studies Major) College Pathways program.

(i3) 2014-SOC-4660 – Program Revisions-Philosophy

The Committee recommends that Senate approve proposed changes to the Philosophy programs, with revisions made in consultation with the Chair of the Department. These revisions included conforming to the definitions (in development) of major and double major programs, adding year level specifications for 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year Philosophy courses, as well as using the new course classification terminology.

(j3) 2014-SOC-4661 – New advanced topics CRIM course

The Committee recommends approval of the new course, Criminology 4090 with title revised as “Special Topics in Criminology”.

(k3) 2014-SOC-4665 – Cross-listing of CRIM 3350 with PSYC 3350 [with 2014-HBS-4514]

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the new course, Criminology 3350, cross-calendared with the new course, Psychology 3350.

(l3) 2015-SOC-4671 – Changes to HBASC.CRIM degree

The Committee recommends that Senate approve proposed revisions to the HBASC (Criminology Major) program. It was clarified that the Fourth Year change from INTD 4010/4032 to CRIM 4801 will become effective immediately.

(m3) 2015-SOC-4676 – Title change OUTD 1070

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the reactivation of Outdoor Recreation 1070 with revised title.

(n3) 2015-SOC-4694 – New Course OUTD 3380

The Committee recommends approval of the new course, Outdoor Recreation 3380, with revisions. The offering hours should be “2-0; 2-0 plus field trip (ranging from 10-14 days)” and a note should be added that students who have previous credit in OUTD 3370 may not take OUTD 3380 for credit.

(o3) 2015-SOC-4698 – New Course OUTD 4920

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the new course, Outdoor Recreation 4920, with revisions. The offering hours should be “3-0; 3-0 plus placement (approximately

6 weeks or 240 hours)". Two restrictive Notes should be added: "Students who have previous credit in Outdoor Recreation 4915 or 4916 or 4917 may not take Outdoor Recreation 4920 for credit. May only be taken by Honours Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation students."

(p3) 2015-SOC-4699 – [POLI 2410] Cross list with MDST 2410 Please see CN request 2014-SOC-4640

The Committee recommends approval of the cross-calendaring of Political Science 2410 with Media Studies 2411.

(q3)2015-SOC-4702 – HBA (Political Science) Pre-Law Revised Comparative Law Section

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the proposed addition of Political Science 3314 and 3332 to the Comparative Politics category in the HBA (Political Science Major) Pre-Law degree.
