# A. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #2-2014 OF FEBRUARY 10, 2014, ITEM 4

.1 Orillia Campus – Specialization in Environmental Sustainability 2014-SCI-4375 (was 2013-ORI-2924)

The Committee wishes to inform Senate that, after extensive discussion, the Department of Environmental Sustainability has decided that the request should be <u>withdrawn/cancelled</u> at this time.

## B. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #7-2014 OF OCTOBER 20, 2014, ITEM 5

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on May 8, 2015 to review the following item that was referred from the October 20, 2014 Senate meeting.

- .1 Faculty of Business Administration
- (a) 2015-BUS-4954 (previously 2014-BUS-4381) Bachelor of Administration (Management)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> that Senate approve the proposed Bachelor of Administration (Management) program, <u>with revisions</u>. The program should be designated as a non-direct entry degree, the course number for Business and Society should be corrected from BUSI 3337 to 3351, an additional sentence should be added to the first note, and the Graduation Requirement should refer to the BAdmin (Management).

### (b) 2014-SOC-4649 - HBOR BEd (Outdoor Recreation) J/I

Similarly, the request 2014-SOC-4649 was <u>cancelled</u> and the new Outdoor Recreation requirements for the new 2-Year program were updated in request 2014-EDU-4404 instead.

#### (c) 2014-SOC-4650 - HBOR BEd (Outdoor Recreation) P/J

As well, the request 2014-SOC-4649 was <u>cancelled</u> and the new Outdoor Recreation requirements for the new 2-Year program were updated in request 2014-EDU-4404 instead.

### (d) 2015-SOC-4672 - Non-direct entry fallback BASC.CRIM degree

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the proposed non-direct entry BASc (Criminology Major) program, with editorial revisions and the removal of the word "only".
