## A. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #2-2014 OF FEBRUARY 10, 2014, ITEM 4

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on October 7 and November 4, 2014 to review items that were referred from the February 10, 2014 Senate meeting, and makes the following recommendations:

#### .1 Orillia Campus – Minor in Environmental Sustainability 2014-SCI-4374 (was 2013-ORI-2923)

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the Minor in Environmental Sustainability, <u>with</u> <u>minor editorial revisions</u>, and with the clarification that it should become effective for the <u>winter 2015 term</u>.

#### B. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #6-2014 OF SEPTEMBER 15, 2014, ITEM 5

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on October 7 and November 4, 2014 to review items that were referred from the September 15, 2014 Senate meeting, and makes the following recommendations:

#### .1 Faculty of Education

#### (a) (2014-EDU-3261) – Mathematics, Primary and Junior Education, Part 1

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the revised course description for Education 4725, with revised start term of Spring 2015.

#### .2 Faculty of Engineering

## (a) (2014-ENGI-4105) – Software – Elective Additions: Adding 2 courses to list of electives for Software students

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the addition of two elective courses to the Category A list in the BEng (Software Engineering) program.

### .3 Faculty of Natural Resources Management

(a) (2014-NAT-3388) HBEM Wildlife Spec Electives The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of changes to the HBEM program, Specialization in Wildlife Conservation and Management revised as:

(a) Natural Resources Management 0390 (non-credit required course)

- (c) Natural Resources Management 2050, 2054, 3116, 3218

- (f) Geography 2251
- (g) Two half-course restricted electives (see Note 1 below)
- (h) One half-course open elective (see Note 2 below)

#### Fourth Year:

- (a) Natural Resources Management 4094
- (b) Natural Resources Management 4212, 4214, 4250, 4251
- (c) Natural Resources Management 4010, 4030
- (d) One half-course restricted elective (see Note 1 below)
- (e) One and one-half FCE open electives (see Note 2 below)

#### Note 1:

Students in the Wildlife Conservation and Management Specialization will choose the 1.5 FCE restricted electives in third and fourth years from: Biology 3219, 3671, 4211, 4231 and 4435

#### Note 2:

It is recommended that students in the Wildlife Conservation and Management Specialization choose open electives from: Biology 3250, 3251, 4111; Natural Resources Management 3217; Psychology 3511

# C. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #7-2014 OF OCTOBER 20, 2014, ITEM 5

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on November 4, 2014 to review items that were referred from the October 20, 2014 Senate meeting, and makes the following recommendations:

#### .1 Faculty of Engineering

#### (a) (2014-3262) - ENGI 2032/2033 Mechanical Deletion

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the deletion of Engineering 2032 and 2033, <u>with</u> <u>end term winter 2015</u>, an associated change for the previously approved request #2014-ENGI-3075 to replace the two courses with a new course, Engineering 2518.

#### (b) (2014-ENGI-4387) - Common Year - 1134 & 1535 Discontinue

The Committee <u>recommends</u> that Senate approve the discontinuation of Engineering 1134 and 1535, <u>with end term winter 2015</u>, an associated change to the program revision in request #2013-ENG-1821 previously recommended for approval.

#### (c) (2014-4273) – Chem ENG Course Additions and Changes

The Committee <u>recommends</u> that Senate approve request 2014-4273 regarding Chemical Engineering courses, <u>with revisions</u>. In addition to the course description changes for Engineering 1554 and 2331, clarifying wording will be added to the offering hours of instruction: for ENGI 1554 "(3 hours lectures plus 1.5 hours tutorials per week in the winter term)" and for ENGI 2331 "(3 hours lectures plus 1.5 hours tutorials per week in the fall term)". The new course will be Engineering 2555 – Unit Operations Laboratory. The course description change for Engineering 0339 is being approved as submitted.

#### (d) (2014-4273) - Chem Prog Change

The Committee <u>recommends</u> approval of the replacement of Engineering 2332 with the new course, Engineering 2555 – Unit Operations Laboratory, in Second Year Winter Term

of the BEng (Chemical Engineering) program, <u>but correcting</u> the Lec/Lab hours to 2-2 to match the course description, <u>as well as revising</u> the title of Engineering 4132.

#### .2 Faculty of Health and Behavioural Sciences

#### (a) (2014-HBS-4396) - Course-Change to Psychology Courses

The Committee <u>recommends</u> that Senate approve the proposed revisions to five Psychology courses in request #2014-HBS-4396, <u>with revisions</u>. The revised prerequisite in PSYC 3081 and 4212 should also include "and permission of the Chair of the Department of Psychology". Because PSYC 2004 is the prerequisite for PSYC 4032 and PSYC 4032 is the prerequisite for PSYC 4033, PSYC 2004 should be removed from the prerequisite statement of PSYC 4033.

#### .3 Faculty of Science and Environmental Studies (b) (2014-SCI-3987) – Bioinformatics Changes

The Committee <u>recommends</u> that Senate approve the changes to the HBSc (Bioinformatics Major) program, <u>with revisions</u>. In addition to the removal of (c) Chemistry 4710 as a required course in Fourth Year, along with the adjustments to elective choices in (a), Chemistry 4710 should be moved from the Core Courses list to Recommended Electives list.

The Committee also notes that a similar change to Fourth Year of the non-direct entry BSc (Bioinformatics Major) 4 Year program should be submitted for Senate approval.
