Subject: Senate Academic Information Technologies Committee Report

The Senate Academic Information Technologies Committee (SAITC) met on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The following issues were discussed:

1. TSC representative, Mr. Andrew Brigham delivered a presentation on security, especially email threats such as spam, spoofing, and phishing. The committee suggests using special courses, and D2L as resources to help educate students and faculty.
2. Technology Implementation Questionnaire (TIQ): 317 professors and contract lecturers responded to the TIQ. Preliminary analysis shows that, Internet access, projection system, document camera, and blackboard/whiteboard are essential technology for teaching. An ad-hoc committee was formed to analyze the data. The full report will be presented to senate later this year.
3. Other: The committee discussed anti-plagiarism software and Scantron.
