# 1. New Proposed Senate Committee

• The committee voted in favour of the following motion indicating support for the creation of a new Senate Committee that would replace the Senate Teaching and Learning Committee:

MOVED to approve, in principle, the creation of a new Senate committee on teaching, learning and technology, to replace the existing STLC, and that the revised, proposed Terms of Reference return to STLC for this committee's review.

#### 2. Ad-hoc committee on Accessibility
