She indicated that the Thunder Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre has set up a mechanism to assist Indigenous students at Lakehead who have been affected by the delays in funding. Indigenous Initiatives can now refer Indigenous students in need of funding directly to the Thunder Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre (807-345-5840) for assistance.

## 11. President's Report

The October 2021 President's Report was circulated in advance with the meeting materials and is available on the Lakehead website at www.lakeheadu.ca.

Highlights from the President's verbal report and discussions that followed included:

- announcement regarding Lakehead and Open Text MOU agreement and the positive opportunities this partnership will bring for Lakehead's Indigenous students
- Orange Shirt Day and National Day for Truth and Reconciliation initiatives - noting that this was the topic of discussion at today's OIEC External Members Caucus, all members were invited to provide feedback regarding the events that Lakehead University held over the last two weeks
- announced that Lakehead had named a new Chancellor, Dr. Rita Deverall
- invited members to share ideas with her regarding new initiatives and supports/services that could help Indigenous students transition to Lakehead

Discussion ensued with regards to concerns with the shortage of certified Indigenous teachers and the lack of programming and opportunities available for Indigenous community members to become qualified teachers.

Administration reported that Lakehead's Chair of Aboriginal Education is working on initiatives to address similar issues and is working with smaller surrounding communities to develop programs. Administration agreed that this is a topic that should be further pursued and plans to connect with the Dean of Education at Lakehead to initiate the conversation, and will report back to the group.

Administration announced that Thunder Bay has been appointed as the next site for the Indspire Teach for Tomorrow.
