- 1. Work has started with the Office of the Registrar on making the HBEd the only direct entry Aboriginal education undergraduate program, with the exception of the BA/BEd and BSc/BEd (Intermediate/Senior) programs.
- 2. The Department has been well represented at various recruitment activities across Northwest Ontario and in Winnipeg. These efforts have already resulted in several applications to the HBEd program.
- 3. Calendar change proposals for the revised five-year HBEd and associated changes to the *Digital Learning and Teaching* and *Native Arts and Crafts* courses have entered into the Senate approvals process. Thanks to all those who have contributed to making this happen.
- 4. The Department is in the early stages of developing a certificate for Education Assistants using a number of first year HBEd courses. Two education authorities are interested in working with us on this. The certificate would involve students registering in the HBEd; they would of course be able to continue with the program if they so chose. Gwen Wodja is broadly supportive of the concept.
- 5. The Department is pleased that the Faculty has permission to advertise for a tenure track position in Aboriginal Education. The position of Acting Chair after 1 July 2014 is currently being discussed with the Acting Dean and VP (Academic). The Acting Dean should be in position to announce a decision in the coming weeks.
