She provided a summary of the Indigenous Engagement Strategy 2014-2019 that's roots stem from a retreat held in June of 2012 that brought together OAG-C and Advisory Committee and community members—exploring the greater needs and issues of Indigenous people in relation to higher education.

Dr. Peggy Smith reported on the Kendaasiwin Steering Committee and plans for outreach community letters of support.
