## Board of Governors' Meeting - March 28, 2013

- Joint Senate / Board of Governors Meeting to highlight communication and planning between these two boards which oversee academic (Senate) and Management (Governors) at Lakehead University.
- Attended March 28<sup>th</sup> Board of Governors meeting. Highlights:
  - Lakehead University Law School Integrated Practical Curriculum Pilot: integrating practical learning throughout the law program instead of articling for period at the end.
    Placement will be assessed and monitored during this program
  - LUCU president to spoke to the board about tuition fee increase of 3%. Board approved an on-going dialogue process with LUCU on points of their letter - 3<sup>rd</sup> party financial review, letter to Premier, more library hours, respect for teachers, adequate learning environment (capital) and better communications between the University and students
  - o President re-appoint process with outside comments, include Aboriginal organizations
  - Appointment of Murray Walberg as incoming chair.
- Attended the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Lakehead University Leaders Breakfast in Toronto at Prospectors and Developers Conference highlighting the work of the Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Mining and Exploration (CESME).
