	Leaderships and community contribution.
Submission	A minimum 90% average.
	Available online, and due by April 15 @ 4:30pm EST.
Decision	The top 5 students will be selected for an interview.
	Two students will be chosen as recipients.
Notification	• Recipients will be notified by email and letter in early May.
