Course Content: By the end of the course students will be able to: correctly apply exponent and logarithm rules; solve exponential and logarithmic equations; graph exponential and logarithmic functions; find general terms of given sequences; recognize arithmetic and geometric progressions and compute terms; calculate limits of infinite sequences; apply the binomial theorem; and test for divergence or convergence of series using a variety of tests.

Labs: The two hour lab on Fridays will give students the opportunity to ask questions about course content and practice problems.

Assignments: Homework will be assigned every week and is to be completed the following Monday via the online homework system WeBWorK. Please note that late assignments will not be accepted under any circumstances, but your lowest assignment mark will be dropped in calculating your final grade.

Tests: There will be three tests worth 15% each (see schedule below). There will be no books, notes, or calculators allowed. Please note that there will be **no** makeup tests. If a legitimate and documented reason is given (i.e. doctor's note) no later than 10 days after missing a test, then the weight will be transferred to the other tests.

Final Exam: The final exam will be scheduled by the registrar during the examination period. It will be a three hour cumulative exam with no books, notes, or calculators allowed.

Bonus Marks: There will be 10 small "quizzes" given during lecture throughout the semester. They will consist of a few short problems related to the lecture material that day. They will not be announced ahead of time and there will be no make up quizzes given under any circumstances. Each quiz completed (regardless of your score on the quiz) will earn you one extra bonus mark on the final exam for up to 10% bonus on the final.
