Value: Up to a maximum of \$500 towards travel expenses for prospective

students to visit Lakehead University

Eligibility:

- 1. You must be:
 - · A Grade 12 high school student.
 - · A Canadian citizen residing in Canada.
 - Reside greater than 150km from the campus you tour.
 - Registered and attending a full-time undergraduate program at Lakehead University beginning in September 2019.
- You must book and participate in a Campus Tour or a Campus Open House event by July 15, 2019. To book your tour or event, visit the Office of Student Recruitment online at www.mylakehead.ca
- 3. Only the following **student travel** expenses are eligible*:
 - Airfare (return travel), or
 - Bus Tickets (return travel), or
 - Personal Vehicle Gas Mileage (return travel; for those traveling more than 150 km oneway from the campus), and/or
 - Hotel Accommodations (Maximum one night accommodation)
- 4. The two-page **Campus Tour Bursary Application Form** must be mailed within 3 weeks after your visit to the Office of Student Recruitment. Original travel receipts clearly indicating the travel dates and total allowable expenses must be submitted with the Application Form. For any airline travel, boarding passes and flight itineraries must be included.
- 5. The Office of Student Awards & Financial Aid will notify you of your eligible bursary amount.
- 6. The bursary will be credited to your Lakehead University Statement of Account and applied towards your tuition fees for the 2019-2020 school year.
- All documentation must be mailed to Lakehead University recruitment. Original copies only, emails and faxes will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

^{*} Please note: Any travel expenses booked using reward points (i.e. frequent flyer programs) will not be considered for reimbursement. Associated travel costs (i.e. flight change fees, checked baggage, on-board entertainment, food and beverages, and/or seat selection fees) will not be considered. Cost of rental vehicles and associated insurance will not be considered. Mileage or travel cost to/from airport will not be considered.
