Development of advanced technical skills in performance as a soloist and as a member of a chamber ensemble (if the study is in performance). Development of advanced technical skills in orchestration (if the study is in orchestration). Expansion of output in composition (if the study is in composition). Application of advanced technical skills in orchestration (if the study is in orchestration). In-depth knowledge of specific historical forms and musical idioms (i.e. 16th or 18th c. counterpoint, opera, oratorio, etc.). Knowledge of specialized music literature (contemporary composition, early music genres, performance repertoire). The course will be offered as an independent study with faculty supervision and/or instruction. It will require a written proposal submitted by the student and supported by the designated instructor. Each proposal will include the title of the topic, how it will be accomplished and how it will be marked.
