Pedagogical rationale for Rationale: College-University transfer programs are currently this proposal. Why are you being promoted by the Ministry of Training, Colleges, and submitting this request?: Universities in order to expand the available pathways for students who otherwise would not be attracted to or eligible for university directly from high school. Our goal is to ensure that transfer students have sufficient background to be successful in upper level courses. Despite the variance among General Arts and Science college programs in terms of depth, they all involve enough breadth to provide an introductory base for a variety of disciplines, fulfilling Lakehead's maximum number of allowable first or zero level courses, which is seven. All college GAAS two-year programs also involve several courses at "advanced level" - equivalent to Lakehead's second or third year level courses, which investigate specific topics or sub-disciplines beyond introductory level. However, since some colleges do not offer more than two one-semester college courses at "advanced level," we would only be giving credit multilaterally for one FCE of such courses at this point, raising the total transfer credits to 8 FCEs. To assist student

<u>selection of such advanced level courses prior to college</u> graduation, a list of courses from each college will be compiled, distributed to the colleges, and placed on our website by the spring of 2014. Graduates from colleges that include more than the minimum advanced level or second year university courses as part of their college programs, may receive up to two FCEs of advanced standing in addition to the 8 FCEs of block transfer To bring the BA (General) Pathways Program up to date.

Will this program impact The addition of college transfer students will increase student enrolment in enrolment in upper level classes. Since many upper level another program within the classes tend to be undersubscribed compared to first year courses, the additional enrolment will be welcome. We do not anticipate large flocks of college transfers, since only students who have achieved 70% or higher in college would be eligible, eliminating the vast majority of college graduates who require only 60% to complete the General Arts and Science diploma. Still, since most high school students choosing to attend college are lacking some of the entrance requirements for university or would normally not even consider university, we are expanding our recruitment base by giving these students an opportunity to complete a university degree after they graduate from college.
