Pedagogical rationale for Therapeutic Recreation is a growing professional field of this proposal. Why are you practice. Currently Therapeutic Recreation Ontario (TRO) is in submitting this request?: the process of professionalizing the profession through regulation and certification. At present, people can write national exams but often do not have all the courses or background to aid them in successfully completing them. This concentration has been developed in conjunction with TRO to ensure that students will have the necessary academic background. In addition, it will be the only program focused on nature-based therapy in the province. Students graduating from TR programs from the college need to have an additional related TR degree to become recognized as a TR professional. Students graduating from TR programs at the University need the diploma to become recognized as a TR professional. By developing this concentration and associated college transfer pathways (2016-SOC-5682), we have created a 5 year educational path (2 at college, 3 at ORPT OR 4 at ORPT and 1 at college) to meet the
