The program requirements for the first three years are the same as for the Honours Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation (HBOR) program. In order to remain in the program, students must maintain at least an overall of 60% (C) average in the major. Students in the four-year Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation (BOR) degree are required to complete four fourth-year Outdoor Recreation electives and three FCE electives at the second year level or higher. Students in the four-year BOR degree may not take Outdoor Recreation 3075, 4075, 4011 or 49204912.

Why are you required for the HBOR, and they have no alternative but to keep submitting this request?: repeating courses to try and achieve the average, or increasingly, they are requesting to transfer into a BA General (which requires many exceptions to be made, as OUTD courses are not considered to be Social Science courses). Their final alternative is to quit university entirely. We would therefore like to create a non-honours fall back option. At the end of the third year, if a student's average is not 70%, they will be put into a BOR degree, which does not allow them to complete an Honours Thesis, a direct studies course, OUTD 4370, or to take our required fourth year placement course. Instead, they complete four 4th year OUTD electives and 3.0 FCE's open electives. Outdoor Recreation 4920 has been discontinued.
