Why are you submitting this request?: ~~Adding 1FCE Honours Thesis Seminar course as a requirement in the 4th year, and reducing the Sociology electives that are required to ensure no extra teaching resources necessary. We also altered the listing to account for the fact that SOCI 4105: Women and Sociological Theory, is being reduced to .5FCE from 1FCE. The pedagogical rationale for that will be provided in that course change. The pedagogical rationale is that employers are increasingly interested in students who demonstrate hands-on, experiential, and independent research work in the form of a thesis. We believe a capstone type seminar course like this will be very beneficial to the students and allow them to apply all of their theory and methods work to a topic of their choice. This is enriching, excellent practical experience, and very useful to leverage for graduate programs or entering the labour market.~~
