The changes for the Psychology courses relate to Psychology's calendar changes Students in this degree pathway (HBOR therapeutic rec) are required to take more OUTD electives than students in the HBOR. They also have more required courses because of the emphasis on PSYC as such it can be a more difficult pathway for students to transfer into.
