1. New Version of a Degree	Honours Bachelor of Arts and Sciences (Media, Film, and Communications Major)
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Justification

These housekeeping changes are required to remove a course that no longer exists (GSCI 0370) and to specify the year level of the electives in years three and four. This latter change is required to prevent students from taking more than the maximum of 7 FCEs at first year level. Occasionally a student in third year might still wish to take a first year course, but that would only be possible if the student has not yet exceeded the maximum of 7 FCEs in total.

Program Requirements:

#### Four Year program

An overall 70% average through each year is required in the Media, Film, and Communications Major (courses designated with an asterisk\*) and any additional elective Media, Film, and Communications courses taken.

#### Note:

By the end of four years (20 FCEs), at least three (3) FCEs must be Type A (Humanities) or Type B (Social Sciences) courses; at least three (3) FCEs must be Type C (Engineering, Mathematical and Natural Sciences) or Type D (Health and Behavioural Sciences) courses; and at least onehalf (0.5) FCE must be Type E courses. The Indigenous Content Requirement is being met by the inclusion of onehalf (0.5) FCE chosen from the list of Type E courses taken in any year of the program (Media, Film, and Communications 2310 or 4550 recommended).
