At least one FCE must be chosen from Area 1; at least one FCE must be chosen from Area 2; and at least one FCE must be chosen from Area 3, including at least 0.5 FCE chosen from Type E English courses.

- (b) One-half FCE in first-year Interdisciplinary Studies
- (c) One FCE in Type C or D courses
- (d) Two and one-half FCE electives
