Readings and lectures will demonstrate how the spread of each is the result of social forces that define disease, shape individual risk and health behavior, and influence access to treatment. Upon completion, students will have a greater understanding of why, despite modern medical advancements, diseases and epidemics prove so challenging to prevent, particularly when they disproportionately affect the most marginalized people in society.
