**RE: Appointment of Dr. Jaro Kotalik as Internal Adjunct Professor**


Dear Dr. Birmingham,

Following graduation from medical school at the Charles University of Prague, Dr. Kotalik specialized in medical radiology and practiced radiation oncology in Thunder Bay for many years. He also served in a number of administrative roles, including an appointment as CEO of Thunder Bay Regional Cancer Treatment centre from 1982-1994. In 1995, he earned a Master of Arts in Medical Ethics and Law from King's College, University of London. He served as an Executive Member on the National Council on Ethics in Human Research from 1998-2005. He founded the Lakehead University Centre for Health Care Ethics, served as its director for many years, and continues to serve as Chair of the Centre's Executive Committee.
