Requirements

HONOURS BA (HISTORY MAJOR) with CONCENTRATION IN PUBLIC HISTORY

Four Year program

A student may enter the Honours BA program in History with a Concentration in Public History after the first, second, or third year, providing an overall B average has been attained in the History courses taken up to that time. To continue in the program, an overall B average must be maintained in the History courses. All courses will be chosen in consultation with the Department. Students intending to proceed to graduate work in History are strongly advised to include courses in a second language in the program of study.

First Year:

- (a) History 1100
- (b) One FCE (full course equivalent) from Type A courses
- (c) Two FCEs from Type B courses
- (d) One FCE elective

Second Year:

- (a) History 2510 and History 2350
- (b) Two FCEs in History at the second year level
- (b) Two FCE electives (History excluded)

Third Year:

- (a) History 3830
- (b) Two and a half FCEs in History at the third year level
- (b) Two FCE electives (History excluded)

Fourth Year:

(a) History 4850 and History 4851

(b) History 4830, or 4831, or History 4832

(c) History 4904 or History 4903

(d) A half FCE in History at the fourth year level

(d) Two FCE electives
