These program changes are not essential because the We are introducing four new Inquiry courses (INTD 30aa, 30xx, 30yy, and 30zz, see 2015-soc-5324) in support of our proposed new concentrations (see 2015-soc-5321). These courses are suitable alternatives for INTD 3010. The only difference between each of them is their specific topic (INTD 3010 is a special topics course), so any of these courses will be suitable prerequisites for INTD 4801. Additionally, we are introducing four new 4th-year Inquiry courses (INTD 48aa, 48xx, 48yy, and 48zz, see 2015-soc-5323). We are also changing the title and course description of INTD 4801 to align it with these new courses.
