<b>Title</b> Francophone Cinema and Literature
<b>Description</b> This course offers an introduction to the relationship between cinema and literature from the Francophone world. It examines the social, political and cultural environment in which the works were created and explore the possible motivations and intentions of the writers and cinematographers chosen. The importance of storytelling, character development and aesthetic techniques of both genres will be emphasized as the varied forms of representation and the ways in which they intersect are studied.
