



MULTI-SESSION TRANSITIONAL CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION AND REGISTRATION (MTCQR)

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



The Multi-Session Transitional Certificate of Qualification and Registration is designed for Teacher Candidates who have completed the first session of a multi-session teacher education program. Successful completion of 2.0 FCE's, plus 10 days' Practicum experience, qualifies Teacher Candidates to apply to the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) for a Multi- Session Transitional Certificate of Qualification and Registration, which can enable them to pursue paid teaching contracts (if available) for the remaining duration of their Practicum.



Ask Teacher Candidates if they will be applying for the MTCQR, there are different recommended practicum implementation schedules and assessment forms to follow for each.



If the Associate Teacher does not feel confident that all MTCQR assessment criteria have been met, they may ask that the student remain in the practicum until the Associate Teacher can confidently sign-off on the Teacher Candidate. At this point, the Faculty Advisor, Associate Teacher and Teacher Candidate should discuss and come up with a plan on how to get the Teacher Candidate to the stage where they can confidently be signed-off on.
