

## **Area Requirements – English Majors**

As part of the English course requirements for their degree, English Majors are required to satisfy breadth requirements within English. Students admitted to the program after 2015 are required to take **1.0 FCE** from each of **Areas 1, 2, and 3** listed below.

[Students admitted prior to 2015 are required to take 1.5 FCE from **Area A** and 1.0 FCE from **Area C** – See below.]

In addition, English majors admitted after 2015 must satisfy the University's Indigenous Content Requirement (Type E) with English courses from the list below.

N.B.: All English courses are 0.5 FCE. English Majors require **two** courses from each of Areas 1, 2, and 3 to satisfy the Department's breadth requirement.
