Lakehead University Work Study Program (Fall/Winter) Cost to Employ a Student

The Lakehead University Work Study Program (LUWSP) for the fall/winter terms provides part-time employment opportunities to eligible undergraduate students during the academic year.

<u>Please find below</u> the maximum subsidy per term (includes wages and the related employer costs, applied against their hourly rate as 100% of the current minimum wage) and the work term dates. Employer budget codes will be charged the total payroll costs and the subsidy will be reimbursed after reconciliation of the period in late April/May.

Important Changes:

- Request to Hire (RTH) must be completed before requesting a position.
- Students can work a maximum of 40 hours between August 26 September 30 (no exceptions).
- If the student works less than the hours listed below, the subsidy will be prorated.
- IMPORTANT! If you are interested in offering a student more than minimum wage and/or additional hours over the maximum hours listed below, it is at the employer's expense and advanced approval by the department's respective Vice-President must be received prior to requesting a LUWSP position.

Note: If your budget code is non-operational (Fund 50 research funds) you do not require an RTH or Vice President approval for additional hours (over max that subsidy covers) prior to requesting a position.
