

Lakehead University Work Study Program (Spring/Summer) Cost to Employ a Student

The Lakehead University Work Study Program (LUWSP) for the spring/summer terms provides **full-time** employment opportunities to [eligible undergraduate students](#).

Please find below the maximum subsidy (includes wages and the related employer costs, applied against approximately 40% of the minimum wage) during the work term dates. Employer budget codes will be charged the total wages/payroll costs. All hours will be included in the subsidy calculations if hours submitted or a *MyLateTimecard* is received within 2 weeks of the work term end date. The subsidy will be reimbursed after reconciliation in mid to late October.

Important Changes:

- [Request to Hire \(RTH\)](#) - submitted or approved before requesting a position (includes Fund 50 research funds).
- Subsidy is based on 480 hours at minimum wage (based on 30 hours/week for 16 weeks) for the work term.
- If the student works less than 480 hours, the subsidy will be prorated.
- **IMPORTANT!** If you are interested in offering a student more than minimum wage and/or additional hours over 480 hours, it is at the employer's expense and **advanced approval** by the [department's respective Vice-President](#) must be approved for the RTH.
- **Work term: April 20 to August 22, 2026 (18 weeks)**

When completing the staff information form, enter the student's hourly wage into the rate of pay field and check the box for 4% vacation pay (included in benefits above) in addition to the quoted rate of pay. Please note the LUWSP Job ID number in the remarks field.
