- Performs mechanical maintenance work through the University's computerized work order system.
- Inspects, investigates and solves problems related to the operation of both the mechanical systems and equipment, providing technical advice as necessary.
- Performs skilled mechanical work on HVAC, refrigeration, heating systems or plumbing at the journeyman level.
- Provides estimates of work for repairs to mechanical systems on campus.
- Makes necessary reports and keeps records and files as required or work orders, requisitions, upgrades and changes to systems etc.
- Takes every precaution reasonable in the circumstance for the protection of the workers in his charge.
- Works in compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act, with other health and safety related legislation and standards, and with such workplace practices as outlined by his immediate supervisor.
- Performs other related duties as assigned from time to time.

Qualifications

- Minimum of five years of directly related journeyman experience in a Maintenance position.
- Must possess a valid journeyman licence, certificate of qualification in but not limited to:
- Plumbing, Refrigeration or Air-Conditioning Mechanic.
- Must possess a valid gasfitter 2 certificate or greater.
- Preferred to have a current Ozone Depletion Prevention Certificate (ODP)
- Must possess a valid driver's licence.
