- 5. The University has in place an Interest Rate Swap Agreement which will expire on October 1, 2036. The University has entered into an interest rate derivative agreement to manage the volatility of interest rates on a term Ioan. The Ioan agreement dated June 10, 2010 with the Royal Bank of Canada in the amount of \$23,500 was used to finance the construction of a residence and cafeteria on the Orillia campus. The University converted floating rate debt for fixed rate debt of 4.69%. The change in the fair value of the interest rate swap has been charged to the Residence ancillary operations.
- 6. General includes municipal taxes, liability insurance, legal and audit fees, university memberships, bad debts and merchant provider costs.
