How do I access my university academic profile?

Your [myInfo](#) account is the quick access portal to your university profile and more. This is the place you will find your program details, [academic standing](#), access your program requirements through “[Student Planning](#)” tool, [declare a minor](#), request a [program change](#) and more.



How do I find my grade information?

Within your [myInfo](#) portal under “[Grades & Transcript](#)”, you have access to your in progress grades, final grades, your unofficial transcript, and the ability to [request an official transcript](#).

Feel like a course is not for you?

If you are not enjoying a course that is in progress, you have options to change your registration(s) using the tools in your “[Course Registration](#)” section in your [myInfo](#) portal, up until the final day to add courses as per the [important dates](#) outlined in the academic schedule of dates in the [Academic Calendar](#). Alternatively, you may be looking to [drop a course](#) and change your registration for another term within the appropriate dates to do so. Finances are stressing me out, what are my options?

How can I get relevant work experience while I am studying?

Experiences like labs, group work, and other forms of experiential learning build skills for your future career. In addition, for eligible students, the Lakehead University Work Study Program (LUWSP) provides part-time work opportunities on campus during the LUWSP Fall/Winter term and 30-35 hour work opportunities on campus during the LUWSP Spring/Summer term.

We also recommend getting involved with co-curricular opportunities including LvL Up Leadership, student clubs on campus, and volunteer[ing] opportunities across the city!
