As a geological assistant, you will gain valuable experience interpreting the interplay of structure, alteration and mineralisation on the various rock types through drill core logging, surface and underground mapping, interpretation of drill sections on paper and in 3D computer programs. Exploration of more grass-roots targets is ongoing throughout the mine's large land holdings and you will be involved in detailed and reconnaissance geological mapping, soil sampling using a variety of advanced analytical techniques, and the generation of drill targets. Musselwhite is committed to the professional development of all employees and will provide opportunities to learn about assaying, milling and refining gold, mining and diamond drilling.
