Detailed Narrative:

The reason for this visit is to respond to a notice made to the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training, and Skills Development. The notice includes the following: Student suffered a loss of consciousness after crushing finger using a crane to move a slab of concrete in the engineering lab.

The field visit took place over the phone and the following was discussed:

The injured person was moving a concrete slab with a crane and crushed their finger. They suffered a Loss of consciousness while getting first aid.

The scene is secured until an inspector can attend the scene and conduct an investigation.

Investigation is ongoing.

Notify the Ministry of fatalities, critical injuries, work refusals, reprisals and unsafe work practices.
