This course offers a regional interrogation of settler colonialism (and its resistance) in northern Ontario. The first half of the course offers a historical critique of the rise of colonial economies and governance systems on the northern shore of the Great Lake. In the second half of the course, students will survey a series of resistance movements led by Anishinabe peoples that includes but is not limited to: blockades, occupations of land, memory walks, community patrol groups, hunger strikes and other grassroots agitations for justice in Anishinabe territory.
