Survey Information:

The Ontario University Graduate Employment Survey is conducted annually to provide insight into students' employment situation six months and two years after graduation from an undergraduate degree program. The survey is administered by the Ontario Universities Application Centre on behalf of the Council of Ontario Universities under a contract with the Ontario Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

Data Source:

• Ontario University Graduate Survey (OUGS): 2016 graduated students from undergraduate programs

About:

- The percentage employed and the average full-time salary of graduates from Lakehead University baccalaureate programs two years after graduation. Data is available for the University as a whole, Lakehead Orillia and Lakehead Thunder Bay.
- The data also includes a comparison of Lakehead University graduates' employment and salary compared to graduates of baccalaureate programs for all Ontario universities two years after graduation.

Criteria:

- Students graduating from an undergraduate program at Lakehead University in 2016
- · Does not include any students who recieved diplomas, certificates, Master's degrees, or Ph.D. degrees
- Includes full-time, part-time, domestic, and international students


Limitations:


