DESCRIPTION

An introduction to the main elements of the Italian language. The development of speaking, reading, and writing skills. Introduction to Italian culture and texts.

OBJECTIVES

To gain a working knowledge and basic fluency of the Italian language. To become familiar with a number of every day conversation pieces, and gain confidence in your ability to converse using the Italian language.

METHODOLOGY

Our class structure will utilize a lecture-based style, with a combination of games/ activities, musical pieces, guest speakers, and listening to video conversations to improve our comfortability with the Italian language. I will attempt to instruct this course as much as possible in Italiano in order to increase our competence and comfortability with the language.

10% - Attendance and Laboratory Participation (I will assign you a mark based on how frequently you attend class/laboratory, and the level of participation you display during our class/laboratory sessions).

10% - Homework Completion / Quizzes (Random checks and quizzes throughout the year to ensure that you are completing your daily assigned work).

DUE DATE- December 1st, 2016

7.5% - Test #1 (This test will include a number of questions testing your comprehension of grammar, conversational pieces, and everyday phrases).

October 6th, 2016

10% - Individual/Group Research Project (You/Your group will be responsible for a 10-15 minute presentation on a topic of your choice involving the country of Italy, their culture/food, and/or a particular facet which you may find interesting. Marks will be awarded for comprehension of subject matter, incorporation of Italian vocabulary, presentation skills, enthusiasm, answering questions, eye contact, and use of voice).

Please select a date and topic during the first week of classes!

For example (Per esempio): Viaggio in Italia

You are to plan a 10 day voyage to Italia - I would like you to prepare a flight itinerary and/or train itinerary around Italy for the time you are spending there. In your description you can include:

- 1) Restaurants you will be visiting plus 13 phrases you cannot travel without. (Please include foods you would like to try and why, and recipes for BONUS.)
- 2) Museums and 20 attractions you would like to visit and why. Please describe at least seven spots, why you would like to visit them in Italian.
- 3) Prices for hotels, you could select one economical and one more expensive hotel in each city you plan to visit.
- 4) Other tourist attractions (spots you would like to visit) and 13 everyday phrases you will need to master prior to departure. This can include shows, music festivals, operas, parades, sport matches, etc.
- 5) Conversion rates and how you plan to budget daily.

Other ideas...

- 1) You could select a historical figure from Italy and prepare a presentation in which you dress up in character and present all your pertinent information from the point of view of your character. (ex. Silvio Berlusconi, Giuseppe Garibaldi, Benito Mussolini, etc.)
- 2) Prepare a recipe
- 3) Feel free to ask me if you need a hand!!!

DUE DATE - Dec. 1st, 2016

7.5% - Test #2 (This test will consist of grammar questions, video comprehension phrases, and a few short answer questions in Italian).

November 10th, 2016

10% - Oral pronunciation & comprehension examination (I will provide you with a short segment to read and you will be marked on your effort displayed and pronunciation capability. You will then be required to answer comprehension questions orally). This will take place twice throughout the year!

7.5% - Test #3 (This test will consist of grammar questions, video comprehension

phrases, and a few short answer questions in Italian).

January 26th, 2017

7.5% - Test #4 (This test will consist of grammar questions, video comprehension phrases, and a few short answer questions in Italian).

March 2nd, 2017

10% - Alfabeto Scrapbook – You will be asked to develop your own Italian Dictionary Book. Each week you will be responsible to include at least one new word, per letter, to fill up your collection. I will discuss this in further detail.

DUE DATE – April 1st, 2017

20% - Final Examination (This will consist of a compilation of grammar exercises, reading comprehension questions, conjugation of verbs, and short answers in Italian).
