Syllabus: Topology of \mathbb{R}^n . Continuity and differentiability of functions from \mathbb{R}^n to \mathbb{R}^m . Taylor's Theorem for functions of n variables. Maxima and minima. The Inverse Function Theorem and the Implicit Function Theorem. Integration in \mathbb{R}^n and Fubini's Theorem. Change of variables in multiple integrals.
