



Final Year 4 BScN Registration Guide – 4 Year & 3 Year Compressed Programs - Fall/Winter 2026-2027

Register for all required courses (Fall & Winter courses) at the time of registration. The BScN Year 4 schedule consists of four six-week blocks, with two blocks in the fall term and two blocks in the winter term. During this time, students will complete three theory courses and three clinical courses, each lasting six weeks. Theory courses are offered **in the fall term only and must be taken all together**. They are available twice during the fall term in two separate six-week blocks. The courses you are registering for are listed below with the appropriate section code. If you register for other sections, you may receive an error message. Review the course Timetable and go to the “Student” tab of your myPortal account to register for courses. One-half course (0.5 FCE) elective	If not taken previously. Total of 1.5 FCE electives required in the Nursing program.
Relational Practice 8 Fall – 1st or 2nd six-week block	NURS-4501-FA (second 6-week block) or FB (first 6-week block) *you cannot take clinical in the same block as theory courses
Relational Practice 9 Winter – 1st or 2nd six-week block	NURS-4502-WA (second 6-week block) or WB (first 6-week block)
Relational Practice 10 Winter – 1st or 2nd six-week block	NURS-4503-WA (second 6-week block) or WB (first 6-week block) Virtual clinical

You must have 1.5 FCE of electives to be able to graduate. The LU degree audit tool on myPortal does not always pick up the electives and may tell you that you do not meet the requirements. We do a manual audit at the School of Nursing, so we will note electives seen even if not identified on myPortal.

In the Winter term, NURS-4502 and NURS-4503 will be offered in both six-week blocks. Students will use the clinical placement platform, HSPnet, to determine when they have been assigned to clinical approximately one month prior. Please watch your Lakehead University email for information about 4th-year placements. Students in NURS-4501 and NURS-4502 follow their preceptor(s) full-time scheduled rotation which is approximately 40 hours/week.

Registration for FB sections (*second 6-week block*) of theory courses is prioritized for students who completed NURS-4501-AA during the summer term.

To be eligible for Year 4 Clinical Placements, you must submit all required documents to Synergy. **The due date is June 1st**.
