



Year 2 Registration Guide- SGEI BScN Program

Register for all required courses (Fall, Full Year, & Winter courses) at time of registration. The courses you are registering for are listed below with the appropriate section code. If you register for other sections, you will receive an error message.

1. Adult Illness Concepts I	NURS-2055 - FY
2. Health & Wellness Concepts I	NURS-2212 - FY
3. Relational Nursing Practice 3	NURS-2511 - FY (Two days a week)
4. Integrated Nursing Sciences I	NURS-2700 - YY
5. Adult Illness Concepts II	NURS-2056 - WY
6. Health & Wellness Concepts II	NURS-2213 - WY
7. Relational Nursing Practice 4	NURS-2520 – WY (Two days a week)
8. One half course (0.5) elective	Elective course of your choice

Courses will be offered via Telepresence or Zoom and most will require in-person attendance at your SGEI site or clinical placement. Dates and times to be announced. Please watch your Lakehead University email for updates.

In the Fall term, **NURS-2511** will have clinical or lab practice two days a week. Further information will be provided early in the Fall term by the clinical course lead via email.

In the Winter term, **NURS-2520** will also have clinical or lab practice two days a week. These dates will not show on your personal schedule. Further information will be provided early in the Winter term by the clinical course lead via email.

To be eligible for Year 2 clinical placements you must submit all required clinical documents to your respective SGEI site. **The due date is June 1**st. Please see the Nursing website for further information about <u>Required Clinical Documents</u>
