

Year 4 Registration Guide – Collaborative BScN Program

Register for all required courses (Fall, Full Year, & Winter courses) at time of registration. The BScN 4th Year schedule is divided into four (4) six-week blocks. The courses you are registering for are listed below with the appropriate section code.

Option 1 - Lakehead University Campus

1. Nursing Leadership	NURS-4050-FC (first 6-week block of Fall term)
2. Nursing Research	NURS-4051-FC (first 6-week block of Fall term)
3. Advanced Topics in Nursing	NURS-4111-FC (first 6-week block of Fall term)
4. 0.5 Elective	If not taken previously, (total of 1.5 FCE electives required in Nursing program).
5. Relational Nursing Practice 8	NURS-4501-FB (second 6-week block Fall term)
6. Relational Nursing Practice 9	NURS-4502-WA or WB
7. Relational Nursing Practice 10	NURS-4503- WA or WB (virtual clinical)

OR

Option 2 - Confederation College Campus

1. Nursing Leadership	NURS-4050-FD (first 6-week block of Fall term)
2. Nursing Research	NURS-4051-FD (first 6-week block of Fall term)
3. Advanced Topics in Nursing	NURS-4111-FD (first 6-week block of Fall term)
4. 0.5 Elective	If not taken previously, (total of 1.5 FCE electives required in Nursing program).
5. Relational Nursing Practice 8	NURS-4501-FB (second 6-week block of Fall)
6. Relational Nursing Practice 9	NURS-4502-WA or WB
7. Relational Nursing Practice 4	NURS-4503-WA or WB (virtual clinical)

Total program requirement for electives = 1.5 FCE. You must have 1.5 FCE electives to be able to graduate. The LU degree audit tool on myInfo does not always pick up the electives and may tell you that you don't meet the requirement. We do a hand audit at the School, so we will note electives even if not identified in myInfo. Not to worry!

In the Winter term, NURS 4502 and NURS 4503 will be offered in both six-week blocks, (WA. Clinical placement balance is the final determining factor as to the order of your winter clinical courses. Students will use the clinical placement platform HSPnet to determine when they have been assigned to clinical. Please watch your Lakehead University email for information about 4th year placements.

To be eligible for Year 4 clinical placements you must submit all required clinical documents to Synergy. **The due date is June 1st.** Please see the Nursing website for further information about [Required Clinical Documents](#)

Remember to check your myPortal account regularly for registration dates and access to the Nursing Fast Pass sessions.
