Each applicant is required to read and comply with the following conditions regarding living in residence at Lakehead University.

- 1. I am responsible for all the charges for my Residence room and board, for long-distance telephone calls made from the long distance authorization code assigned to me and for damages and/or losses that I am deemed to be accountable for by the Residence Office or the University, including my share of common area damages. Residence Meal Plans, including declining balance dollars, are non-refundable and cannot be carried forward to the next academic year.
- Failure to abide by the financial arrangements required by the University, or failure to make payment of telephone charges or other assessments, will result in the University withholding my examination results, transcripts or degree.
- I may not change rooms without the consent of the Residence Office in consultation with the Manager, Residence Life and Admissions.
- 4. It is my responsibility to arrange for insurance coverage for my personal possessions which I bring into residence. The University does not assume liability for damaged, lost or stolen items of personal property.
- The Spring/Summer 2016 occupancy period in residence ends on August 20, 2016 (unless a student will be living in Residence for the 2016-2017 Fall/Winter Academic period).
- If I am found to be possessing, using or trafficking illegal drugs or substances, I understand that my residence contract may be immediately cancelled and I may be required to vacate my assigned room immediately.

- 7. Behaviour considered harassing or violent will result in immediate eviction from residence.
- 8. If I choose to leave residence, or are required to leave for disciplinary reasons, before the end of the occupancy period, I will be responsible for all charges related to my residence room assignment (including, but not limited to, room, activity fee, disciplinary penalties, long distance charges, etc.) for the remainder of the contract.
- 9. If I am found to be in violation of any Level 3 offence, I understand that my residence contract may be immediately cancelled and I may be required to vacate my assigned room immediately.
- 10. In the event of an emergency, and at the sole direction of Lakehead University, personal information may be disclosed to emergency personnel and emergency contacts. With your consent, we may also disclose personal information to internal departments and outside social agencies to facilitate any needed treatment.
- 11. I understand that photos and/or recordings may be taken throughout the year to support Residence and Residence Life events.
